Adoption of the 2017-2018 Budget

On the motion by Dr. Parker, seconded by Mrs. Graf, and carried unanimously, Be It Resolved that the Riverside Township Board of Education hereby approves the adoption of the 2017-2018 Annual Budget Statement which sets the amount of the total budget, with a tax levy as follows:

Be It Further Resolved that the Riverside Township Board of Education hereby includes in the proposed budget the adjustment for banked cap in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-10.3(b). The district has fully exhausted all eligible statutory spending authority and must increase the base budget in the amount of \$76,699, for the purposes of installation of new flooring and technology purchases.
