SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**Riverside Township District Goals (2013 – 2014) Final Update**

1. Ms. Ehrich reported that Goal #1 - Staff and administration will work collaboratively to develop and implement the effective use of Student Growth Objectives (SGO's) by November 2013 and allow for revisions if necessary by February 2014.

All SGO's have been uploaded and are currently being scored by administration.

2. Ms. Ehrich reported that Goal #2 - Update all policies identified in the 2012-2013 school year as in need of editing, revision and updates.

We are seeking first reading approvals on our final 15 policies tonight and will formally adopt them at our July 10th meeting.

3. Ms. Ehrich reported that Goal #3 - Implement Achieve NJ Teacher and Principal Evaluation requirements by June 2014.

Administrators are scheduling and completing summative evaluations for all appropriate administrators and teaching staff members.

4. Ms. Ehrich reported that Goal #4 - Prepare for the impending 2015 PARCC (Partnership for the Assessment of Readiness for College & Careers) assessment by spring 2015.

All three schools participated in PARCC field testing.

An additional mobile lab has been budgeted for and is being purchased for the 2014-15 school year.

Our Technology Specialist continues to network with his technology colleagues and attend relevant meetings in an effort to keep the Superintendent and administration informed of necessary PARCC technology readiness information.
