ABOLISHING POSITIONS

The Board of Education will provide the professional staff necessary for the economical and efficient implementation of the instructional program of the district. The Board reserves the right to abolish positions and reduce district staff commensurately whenever reasons of economy, reorganization of the school district, reduction in the number of pupils, or other good cause so warrant.

The Superintendent shall continually review the efficiency and effectiveness of the district organization and recommend to the Board the abolishment of positions and the reallocation of duties and positions.

The Superintendent shall collect and maintain the information requisite to the calculation of each tenured teaching staff member's seniority status. He or she shall develop and maintain district seniority lists and shall recommend dismissals and transfers in a reduction in force in accordance with those lists. No seniority list shall be a public document or published in the absence of a reduction in force or reemployment from a preferred eligible list.
